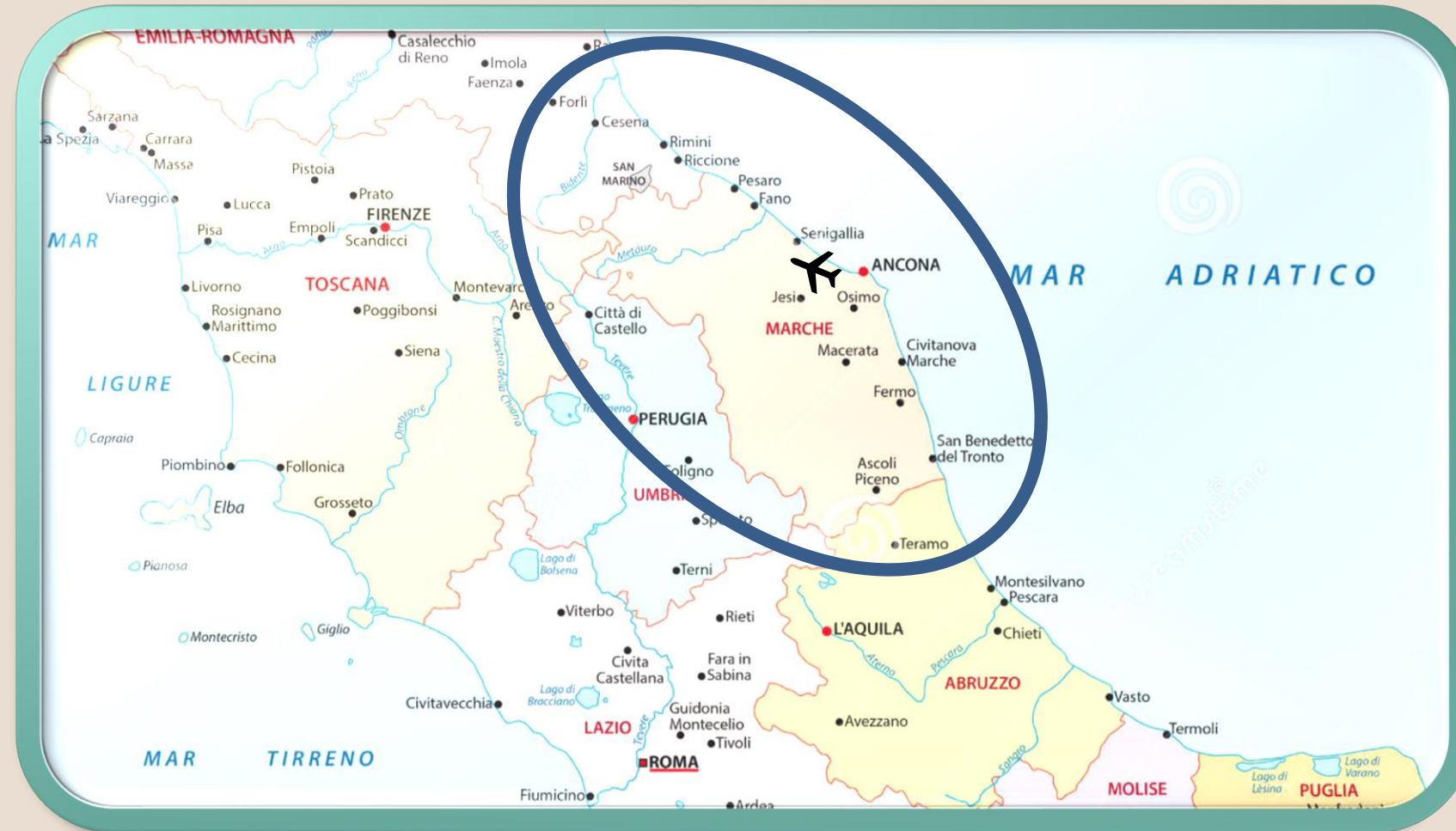

Location of Ancona Airport (AOI)



Ancona airport is located on the Adriatic coast and its catchment area potentially extends beyond the regional borders, including part of the neighboring regions - Romagna, Abruzzo and Umbria.

In the National Airport Plan proposed by Enac in October 2022, Ancona airport was classified as the principal airport of the central network which also includes Perugia and Pescara airports.

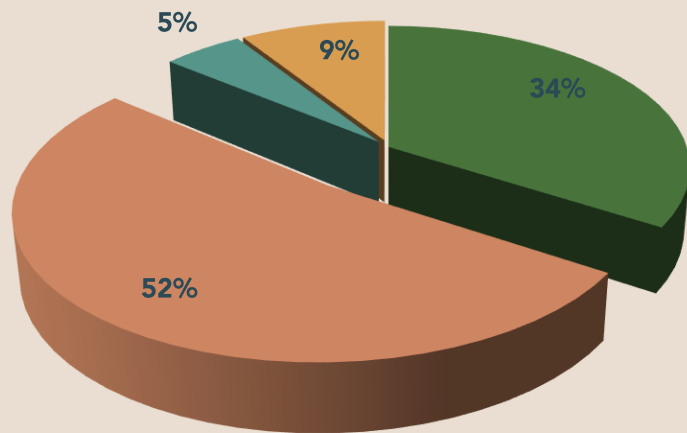

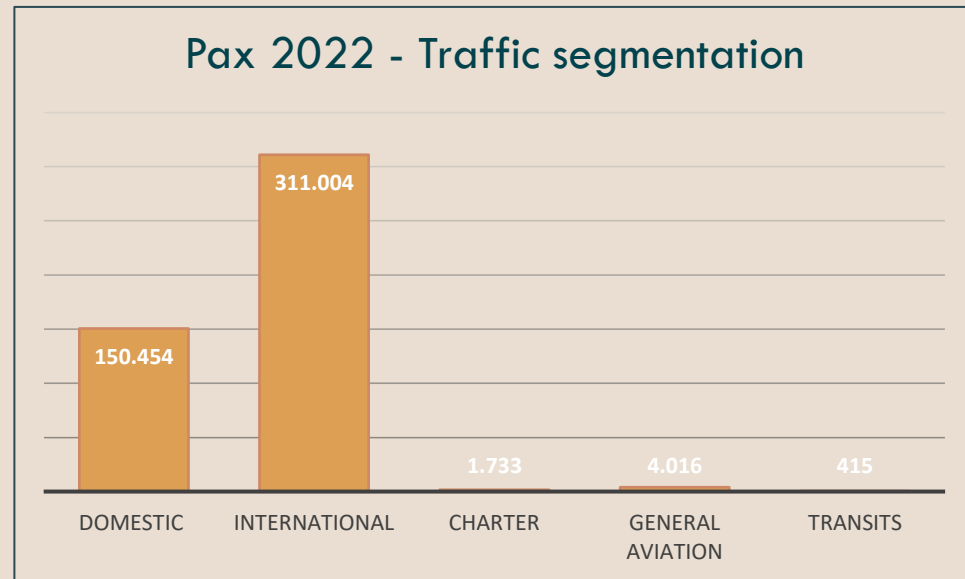

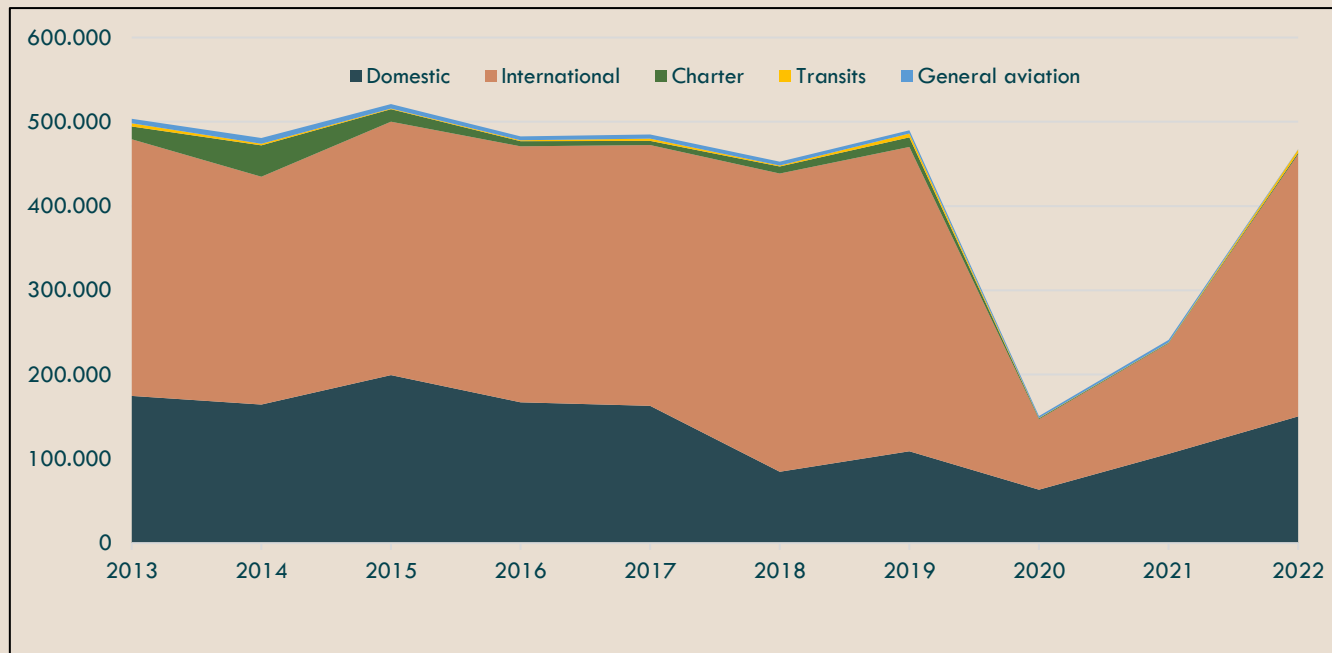

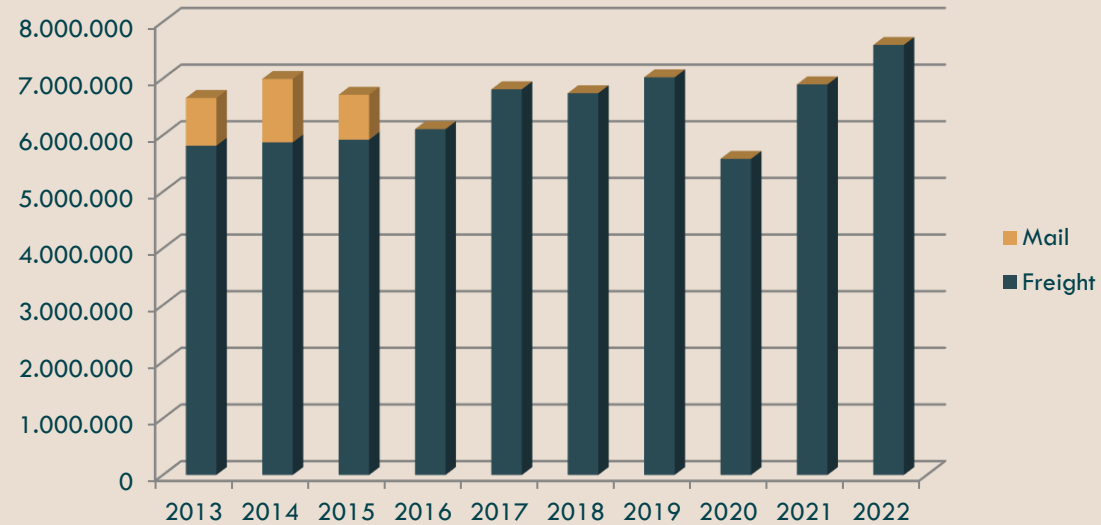

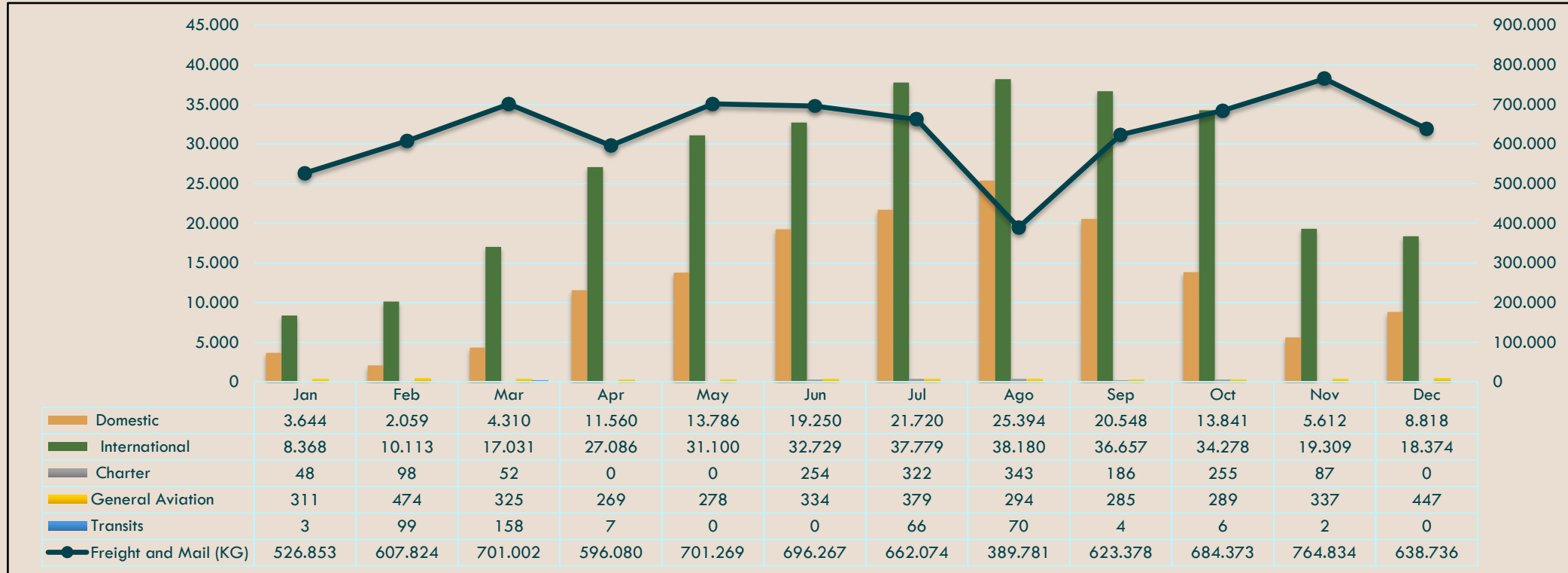

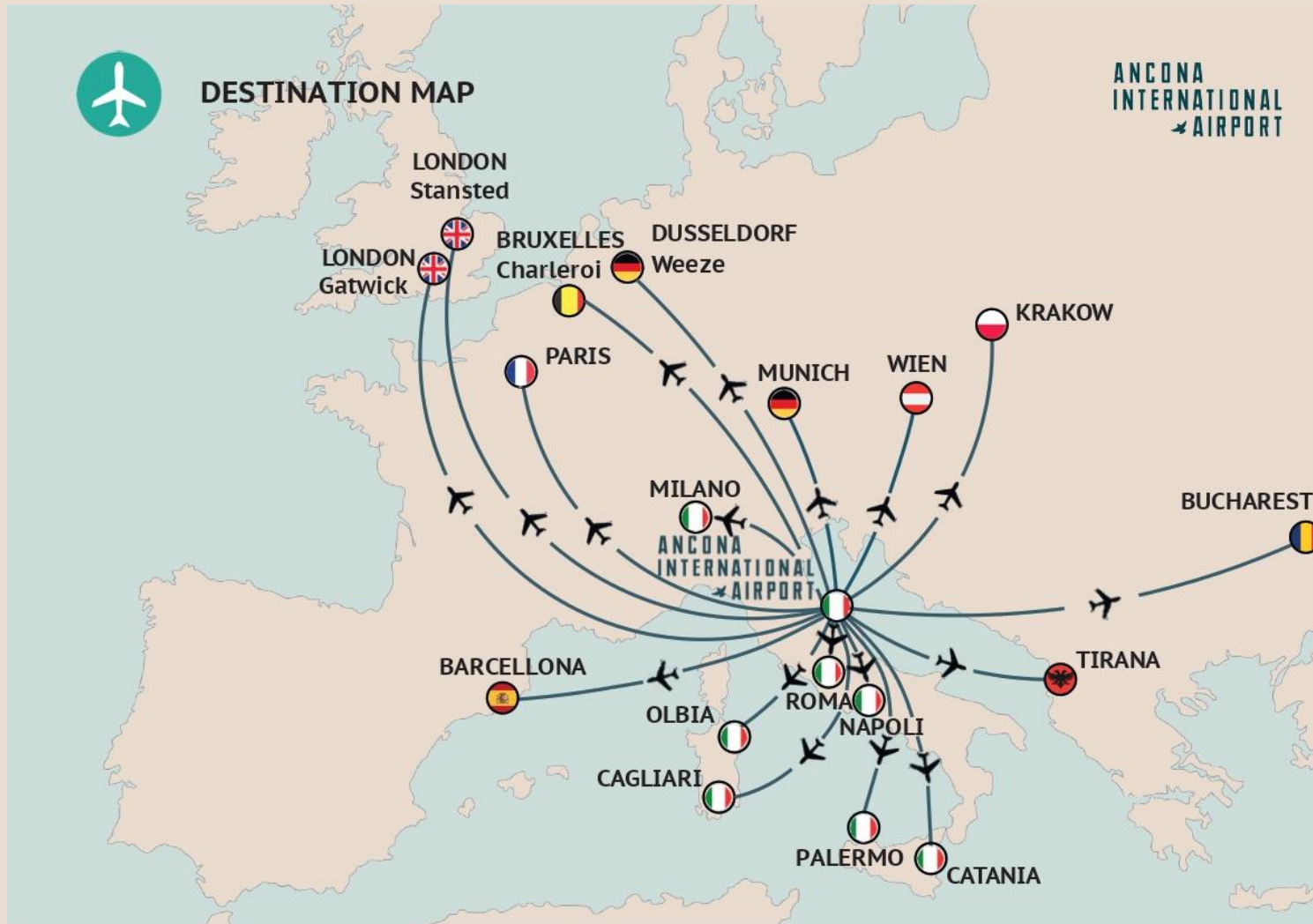

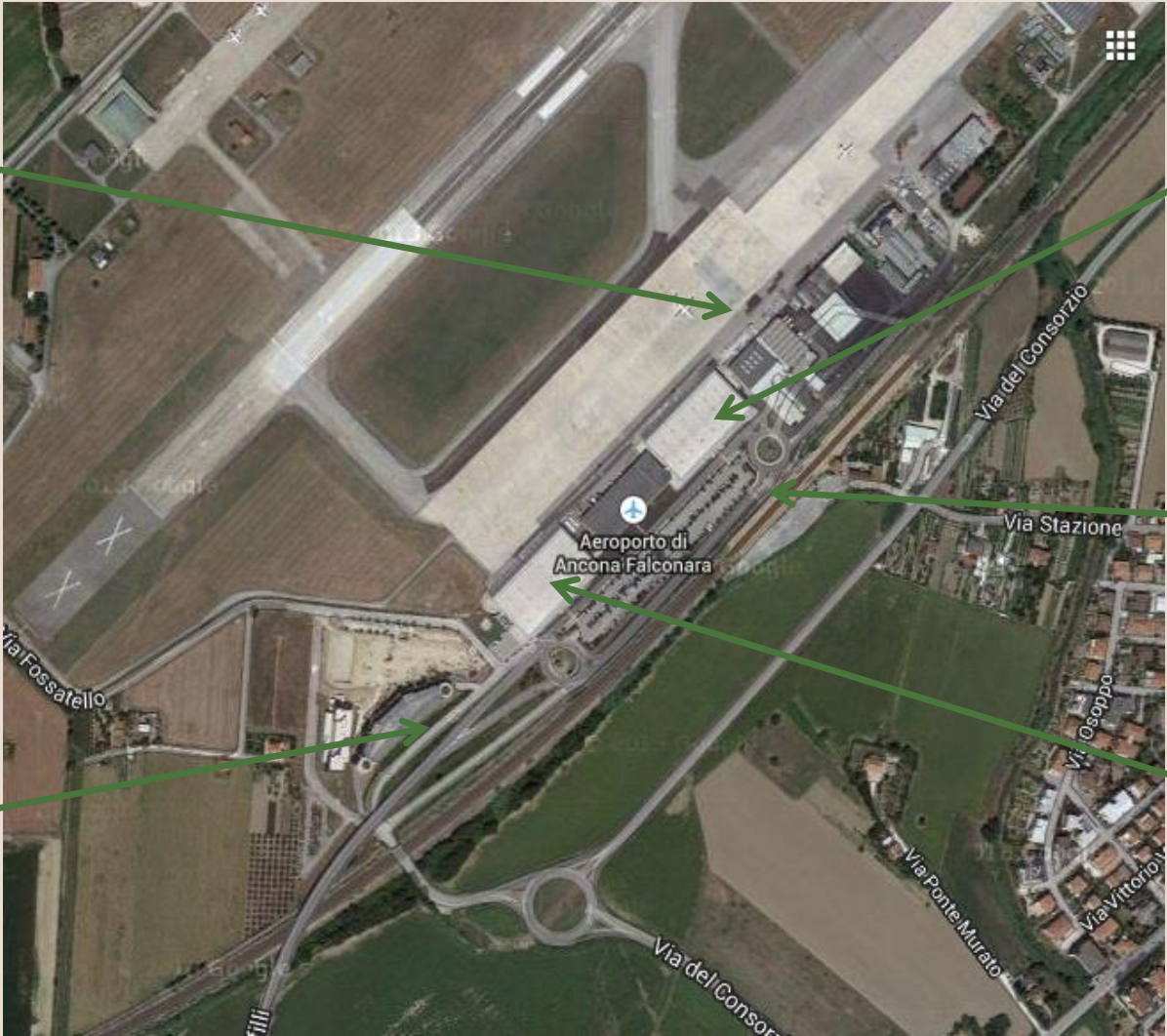

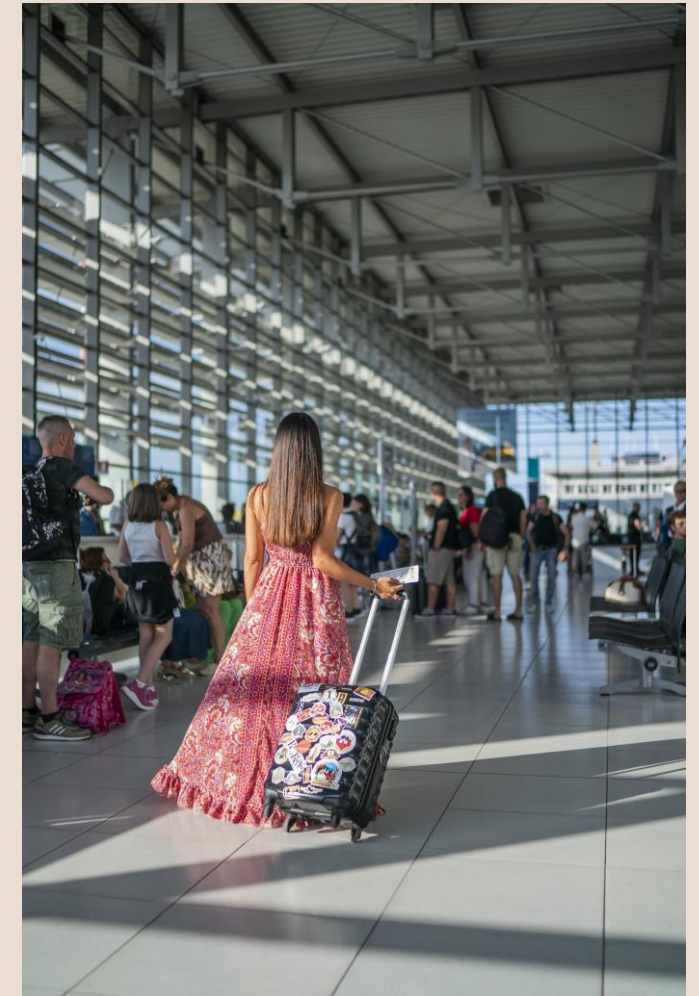

Five good operational reasons to choose Ancona Airport

- New infrastructure, made in glass and steel, inaugurated in December 2004: bright, open, innovative;
- Easy operations for passengers (check-in, security checks and gate very close one to each other) and aircraft turnarounds;
- Opportunity to deal just with one single supplier as Ancona International Airport is both handler and Aerodrome Operator;
- Not a seasonal Airport, acting both on passengers and cargo business;
- High percentage of Business Travel (good balance between leisure and business).

Five good logistic reasons to choose Ancona Airport

- Strategic gateway connecting Eastern Europe, the Balkans and the South Eastern EMEA;
- Located right in the middle of the Adriatic Coast (between VCE/BRI);
- Perfectly connected to the railway network, thanks to a new Aerobus service which links the airport to Ancona and Falconara railway stations. At 100 metres distance Castelferretti railway station with 30 daily trains arriving/departing to/from Falconara, Ancona, Jesi and Fabriano;
- Ancona airport, Jesi Interporto (just 7 km away) and the Port of Ancona (13 km away) constitute an intermodal hub of great value for the development of the entire Marche region.
- Flights to different destinations in Europe.

Five good economic reasons to choose Ancona Airport

- Competitive prices and incentive scheme for strategic partners;
- Heavy and regular support to airlines through a massive communication campaign throughout the enlarged catchment area;
- Quarterly meetings with local Tour Operators and Travel Agencies and constant contacts with 126.000 corporations across the whole catchment area;
- Local market with huge potential for growth;
- High demand of cargo shipment.
